Pre Admission Risk Assessment

A pre admission Risk assessment MUST be completed in all cases before each young person may be introduced to 'Companions'.

This accord with the National Minimum standards for Children's Homes (NCS 5.7) and is the subject of Compliance inspection under the Children's Homes Regulations (Sched. 6 [14]).
